The votes were chosen according to their relevance and importance to Liberty Counsel Action's key mission concerns, including issues impacting religious freedom, the sanctity of human life, and the family. LCA also has a keen interest in fiscal issues and the management of the national debt since these issues dramatically impact every American family.

As never before, America's Christian citizens must be informed and active in our nation's political processes! COVERING THE 112TH CONGRESS, FIRST & SECOND SESSIONS

★★★ SENATE ISSUES ★★★

1.) H. CON. RES. 35

Senate Rejected, 53 to 47 (4.14.11)

A budgetary resolution to defund the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (ObamaCare), rendering it ineffective. **Liberty Counsel Action was in favor of this resolution.**

2.) H. CON. RES. 36

Senate Rejected, 58 to 42 (4.14.11)

A budgetary resolution to eliminate taxpayer funding of the Planned Parenthood Federation of America and affiliated agencies. **Liberty Counsel Action was in favor of this resolution.**

3.) S. 365 BUDGET CONTROL ACT OF 2011

Passed Senate, 74 to 26 (8.2.11)

Establishes a super committee that has the ability to raise taxes and which is required, by November 23, 2011, to find ways to reduce the deficit by \$1.2 trillion. If the super committee, comprised of six Democrats and six Republicans, cannot agree to the cuts, this bill requires defense and security spending to automatically be cut by hundreds of billions of dollars. Contains few immediate cuts and does little to reform spending measures and, in fact, was insufficient for retaining a AAA rating by Standard and Poor's. **Liberty Counsel Action was against passage of this bill.**

4.) S. 679 PRESIDENTIAL APPOINTMENT EFFICIENCY AND STREAMLINING ACT OF 2011

Passed Senate, 79 to 20 (6.29.11)

Exempts presidential appointments to the cabinet, commissions, and executive boards from the Senate confirmation requirement, giving the President unchecked appointment power. **Liberty Counsel Action was against passage of this bill.**

5.) CLOTURE MOTION ON THE NOMINATION OF JOHN J. MCCONNELL, JR.

Passed Senate, 63 to 33 (5.4.11)

Vote on agreement to discontinue debate and move to final vote on the nomination of "Jack" McConnell for the U.S. District Court in Rhode Island. McConnell is a strong advocate against business, and for judicial activism. He will replace Judge Ernest C. Torres. **Liberty Counsel Action was against this nomination.**

6.) CLOTURE MOTION ON THE NOMINATION OF GOODWIN LIU

Senate Rejected, 52 to 43 (5.19.11)

Vote on agreement to discontinue debate and move to final vote on the nomination of Goodwin Liu to the position of Judge on the Ninth Circuit Court. Liu is a trial lawyer with only one case argued at the appellate court level. He has drawn significant criticism for failing to disclose 117 controversial scholarly writings and speeches to a Senate committee, as well as favoring judicial activism. **Liberty Counsel Action was against this nomination.**

7.) S.J. RES. 6 RESOLUTION OF DISAPPROVAL OF THE FCC'S ATTEMPT TO REGULATE THE INTERNET

Senate Rejected (11.10.11)

A Resolution to disapprove of the Federal Communications Commission's proposed rules that would regulate the internet and change the broadband industry practices, burdening Americans and technological innovation. **Liberty Counsel Action was in favor of this Resolution.**

8.) SENATOR BLUNT'S AMENDMENT 1520 TO S. 1813

Tabled (3.1.12)

An Amendment to protect those with religious and moral objections from being forced to comply with the Health and Human Services mandate that required all organizations to provide health insurance that covered abortion-inducing drugs without a co-pay. **Liberty Counsel Action was in favor of this Amendment.**

9.) CLOTURE MOTION ON THE NOMINATION OF MARI CARMEN APONTE

Passed Senate (6.14.12)

A nomination for U.S. Ambassador to the Republic of El Salvador, despite Latin American groups' disapproval of Aponte because she wrote a scathing article condemning El Salvador for affirming the biblical definition of marriage. **Liberty Counsel Action was against this nomination.**

10.) DISCLOSE ACT S. 3369

Passed Senate (7.17.12)

An Act to require organizations that engage in political speech to disclose to the federal government information, including the names and addresses of some of their donors and whether they contributed to specific political campaigns. **Liberty Counsel Action was against this Act.**

Repeals the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (ObamaCare), and re-establishes legal provisions on health care in place prior to its enactment on 3/23/2010. **Liberty Counsel Action was in favor of this resolution.**

2.) H. CON. RES. 35

Passed House, 240 to 185 (4.14.11)

A budgetary resolution to defund the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (ObamaCare), rendering it ineffective. **Liberty Counsel Action was in favor of this resolution.**

3.) H. CON. RES. 36

Passed House, 241 to 185 (4.14.11)

A budgetary resolution to eliminate taxpayer funding of the Planned Parenthood Federation of America and affiliated agencies. **Liberty Counsel Action was in favor of this resolution.**

4.) H.R.3 "NO TAXPAYER FUNDING FOR ABORTION ACT"

Passed House, 251 to 175 (5.4.11)

Prohibits federal funding for abortion procedures, as well as prohibiting abortion through any healthcare service provided by a federal healthcare facility or individual employed by the federal government. **Liberty Counsel Action was in favor of this bill.**

5.) H.R. 1216 (AMENDMENT 298 BY VIRGINIA FOXX)

Passed House, 234 to 182 (5.25.11)

An amendment to the Public Health Service Act, converting federal funding for graduate medical education in health centers from direct funding to funding by authorization. This is important in eliminating government funding for abortion training and procedures. **Liberty Counsel Action was in favor of this amendment.**

6.) H.R. 1540 NATIONAL DEFENSE AUTHORIZATION ACT

Passed House, 322 to 96 (5.26.11)

Authorizes appropriations for fiscal year 2012 for the military activities of the Department of Defense and the Department of Energy. Includes provisions that prohibit taxpayer funds from being used to undermine the military and the family by ensuring the inclusion of homosexuals in the military will not undermine the effectiveness of the military, by confirming that the Defense of Marriage Act's definition of marriage applies to military families, and by ensuring Department of Defense properties and members of the Armed Services are only used for marriage ceremonies that comply with the Defense of Marriage Act. **Liberty Counsel Action was in favor of this bill.**

7.) S. 365 BUDGET CONTROL ACT OF 2011

Passed House, 269 to 161 (8.1.11)

Establishes a super committee that has the ability to raise taxes and which is required, by November 23, 2011, to find ways to reduce the deficit by \$1.2 trillion. If the super committee, comprised of six Democrats and six Republicans, cannot agree to the cuts, this bill requires defense and security spending to automatically be cut by hundreds of billions of dollars. Contains few immediate cuts and does little to reform spending measures and, in fact, was insufficient for retaining a AAA rating by Standard and Poor's. **Liberty Counsel Action was against passage of this bill.**

8.) H.R. 2560 CUT, CAP, & BALANCE ACT OF 2011

Passed House, 234 to 190 (7.19.11)

Attempts to cut spending by making any action by Congress that would cause federal spending to exceed the debt limit out of order, with certain exemptions; Cap spending through establishment of new budgetary requirements related to national Gross Domestic Product; Prohibits the Secretary of the Treasury from additional borrowing until a balanced budget amendment to the Constitution is submitted to the states for ratification. **Liberty Counsel Action was in favor of this bill.**

9.) H. CON. RES. 13 "IN GOD WE TRUST"

Passed House (11.1.11)

A Resolution to affirm "In God We Trust" as the motto of the United States of America, recognizing the rich Christian heritage of the United States, the Christian principles upon which her government was founded, and the Christian legacy of many of the Founding Fathers. **Liberty Counsel Action was in favor of this Resolution.**

10.) PRENDA, H.R. 3541

House Rejected (5.31.12)

An Act to make it illegal for doctors to take the lives of unborn babies when the doctors know the mother intends to kill her unborn baby because of the baby's sex or race. The Act did not penalize the mother, but required doctors to refuse to provide such abortions. **Liberty Counsel Action was in favor of this Act.**

11.) REGARDING HOLDER CONTEMPT CHARGE H. RES. 711

Passed House (6.28.12)

A Resolution to hold Attorney General Eric Holder in Contempt of Congress for the Department of Justice's refusal to comply with the House Government Oversight Committee's subpoena of documentation relating to Operation Fast and Furious. **Liberty Counsel Action was in favor of this Resolution.**

12.) REPEAL OF OBAMACARE ACT H.R. 6079

Passed House (7.11.12)

An Act to repeal the health-related portions of both, the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act and the Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act, comprising Obamacare, which has caused the average price of health insurance plans to increase exponentially. **Liberty Counsel Action was in favor of this Act.**
